STALLION SERVICE AND BOARDING AGREEMENT

During the season of 2004, on the conditions listed below:

1. The stallion service fee will be: \$_____, payable as follows:
 - A. One half of the stallion service fee will be due upon acceptance of this agreement as a booking fee. **THIS FEE IS NON-REFUNDABLE.** The mare will not be covered until this payment is made.
 - B. **The remaining half of the fee will be due and payable when the mare is checked in foal @ 45 days or when she leaves the farm if prior to 45 days, (if the mare changes ownership, all fees and charges become payable immediately).**
2. Al-Marrah guarantees a live insurable foal if the mare remains at Al-Marrah until pregnancy is confirmed at 45 days gestation. A live foal is defined as any foal that passes an insurance exam at 24 hours old. If the mare leaves Al-Marrah prior to the 45 day confirmation of pregnancy, the guarantee will be void. Responsibility for having the foal examined by a veterinarian at 24 hours remains with the mare owner.
3. If, after complying with the terms of paragraph two, above, the mare is found open from the above

service, upon written request accompanied by a veterinarian's certificate, Al-Marah will re-breed the mare the following season for a handling fee of \$250.00 plus normal expenses.

4. The policy for colts that are gelded: If you geld a colt of a stallion with a stud fee of \$2500, you get a breedback at half the stud fee. In order to qualify the colt will need to be gelded before it reaches one year old. A Veterinarian Certificate including date of geld, will need to be provided to Al-Marah to receive the discount. If we are no longer standing the stallion you may breed back to any other stallion of your choice providing the stud fee does not exceed \$2500.
5. We require 48 - hour notice when you are bringing your mare to Al-Marah. The mare must arrive prior to 4:00 p.m. There will be an extra charge for mares brought during off hours.
6. We will no longer accept mares that arrive one day and are taken home that same day after breeding. We hope to approach a 90% pregnancy rate on mares and we want the best for your mare.

THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED!

7. When a mare arrives at Al-Marah, the Owner must provide:
 - A. Health Certificate - By a licensed veterinarian, attesting that the mare is free of infectious or communicable disease. If a mare arrives without a health certificate, she will be stabled in the isolation pen until we receive the health certificate.
 - B. Negative uterine culture and cytology (if the mare is open).
 - C. Health Record - Immunization and worming for the previous twelve months, including worming 30 days prior to arrival.
 - D. Breeding History - Al-Marah will provide a form to give information to assist the planning for the service.
8. Any board, foaling charges, veterinary charges, and any and all other charges and expenses incurred by Al-Marah on behalf of, or for the benefit of, the owner shall be billed monthly, and all outstanding charges shall be paid prior to the time of the mare's departure. A stallion service certificate will be provided by Al-Marah only upon payment of the service fee and any and all other amounts which may be due and owing to Al-Marah. If any amount due is not paid when due, a finance charge of 2 percent per month shall be charged until the total amounts are paid.
9. This contract may not be assigned or transferred without the written permission of Al-Marah Arabians. Al-Marah reserves the right to offer an exchange of stallion used "at our discretion" due to extenuating circumstances, i.e. availability of stallion due to show schedule, extreme temperatures, lease to third party, etc. There shall be no substitution for the approved mare without the prior written consent of Al-Marah.
10. Al-Marah reserves the right to have the mare examined and to provide treatment of any condition by a qualified veterinarian when such, in the opinion of Al-Marah, will insure the well being of the mare. Such examination and treatment of the mare will be undertaken at the owner's expense.
11. There will be no obligation to cover a mare which is deemed to be in unfit breeding condition. This determination shall be at the sole discretion of the attending veterinarian. Al-Marah reserves the right to return to the owner, at the owner's expense, any unfit mare.

12. Stallion owner, or farm owner, or agents where the stallion stands, shall not be liable for loss, damage, or injury to the mare, the foal by her side, or the newborn foal. The owner assumes all risk of loss or damage to the mare or foal and will insure against such loss at the owner's discretion.
